As a prospective member please review "The Standing Rules Of The 100's Motorcycle Club" (attached). See below for a Prospective member's summary:

1. Initiation fee for prospective members is \$20.00.
2. You must purchase and wear a bib when participating in events as a prospective member.
3. Voting of new members will be by secret ballot. Voting will occur at the next meeting following prospective member's completing application requirements. Attending members will vote. An affirmative majority vote is required. Then congratulations are in order.
4. When club votes the prospective member to full membership, the new member must purchase a club jersey. The club jersey or bib is to be worn when competing in club events.
5. An active member of the club must sponsor prospective members.
6. Prospective members serve a two-month probationary period before being considered for a vote into full membership.
7. All members and Prospective members are expected to attend work party weekend and race weekend.
8. Prospective members must meet the following requirements unless specifically waived by a vote of the club:
 - a) Attend all meetings unless prior notice is given
 - b) Participate in 50% of all District 37 race events.
 - c) Serve one mandatory gas pit.

We are an active racing club as our primary interest, not only as participants, but also as the promoting club of our annual National Championship Weekend. Non-racers are welcome as members provided they have an active interest in participating in Club and District 37 events.
